



Farmer's Fact Sheet: Balewrap Recycling



- Smithers Recycling Depot will take your plastic balewrap free of charge
- Please do your part to clean used balewrap by removing excessive amounts of dirt, hay, or moisture. Suggestions: shake balewrap to eliminate rocks and stones, let the rain wash away hay and dirt, drain off remaining water.
- Do not tie the material with twine or put it into bags, roll it into small bundles.
- The Smithers Recycling depot is open 7 days/week during daylight hours and also accepts all paper products, cardboard, magazines, newspapers and #2 plastics for recycling. Glass and Tin can be recycled at the Transfer Station (the old dump).

Open burning of plastics is a serious health hazard. Teach our children well.
