The BVL D Airshed Management Society is an incorporated non-profit society with charitable status. AMS is committed to reducing the impact of particulate matter on human health through the continuous improvement of air quality in the Bulkley Valley - Lakes District of northwestern British Columbia.

Since November, 2006, The BVL D Airshed Management Society has been delivering the Skeena – BVL D Woodstove Exchange Program, a community-based program providing education and incentives to encourage residents to upgrade from older smokey wood stoves to new EPA certified models that are safer, use less wood, and reduce emissions by up to 90%. To date, we have exchanged nearly 400 wood stoves.

The Woodstove Exchange Program is expanding this fall but will be winding down by April, 2010 and both the BVL DAMS web-site and the Woodstove Exchange web pages are needing to be updated.

### **The Position:**

We are seeking a creative web design individual to update and re-vamp both the BVL DAMS web-site and the Woodstove Exchange web-pages as well as to ensure functioning links from program partners and other web resources.

### **Qualifications:**

- Current resident of either Regional District Kitimat-Stikine or RD Bulkley-Nechako with good local community connections.
- Creative and experienced web designer.
- Good written and oral communication skills.
- Experience in community-based social marketing an asset.
