



As the Scientific Director of Environmental Health Services at the BC Centre for Disease Control (BCCDC) and the Scientific Director of the National Collaborating Centre for Environmental Health (NCCEH), and Professor School of Population and Public Health, Dr. Sarah Henderson, PhD oversees a broad program of applied research, surveillance, and knowledge translation to support evidence-based environmental public health policy and practice in BC and across Canada.

"This role requires me to be a generalist rather than a specialist, and my work spans a wide range of topics including: air pollution from all provincially relevant sources (wildfire smoke, residential wood smoke, industry, road dust, shipping, and vehicles); extreme weather events; radon gas; food safety; water quality; and exposures managed by the Drug and Poison Information Centre (DPIC). Most of my work requires the collection, processing, integration, analysis, and communication of health and environmental data, for which I am a proficient and enthusiastic user."

Vickie Irish is an Air Quality Meteorologist for the Air Quality Section (Assessment and Stewardship) EMAB | EPD | ENV. Previously, Vickie was a High School Teacher, a Whistler Peak Site Operator at Environment and Climate Change Canada and also held positions at TELUS World of Science, UBC, Springwest Academy, VIP Ski and more. Vickie received a Master of Philosophy (MPhil) degree from University of Cambridge and a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) from UBC.

Wayne Kooy B.Sc., P.Ag is the Director of Environment (North America) at Drax Group. Here he is responsible for overseeing the company's environmental operations and initiatives across the region. Prior to his current role, Wayne served as the Senior Manager of Regional Environmental Northern Operations at Drax Group. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Saskatchewan, where he developed a strong foundation in environmental science and management.
